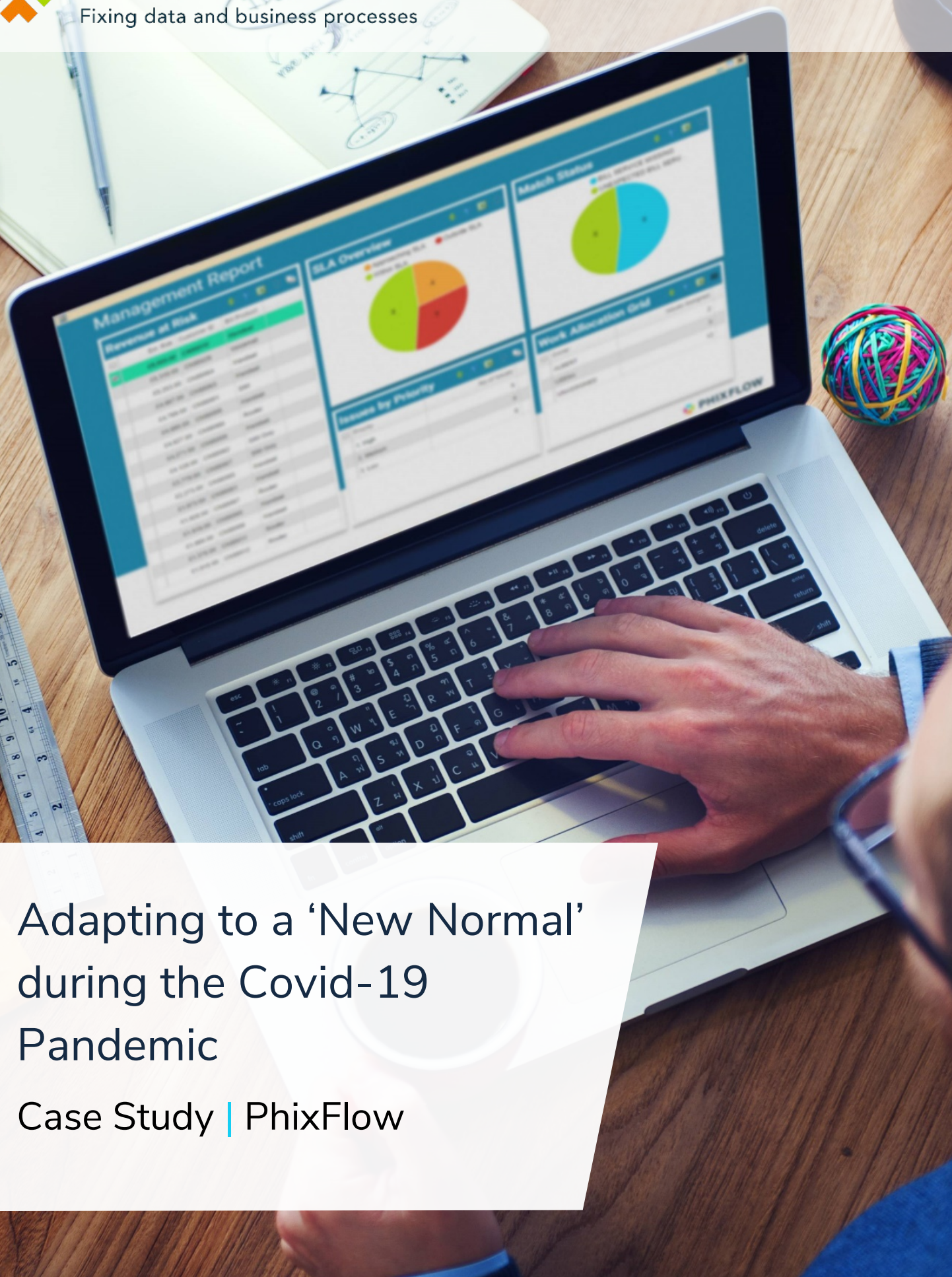

Case Study | PhixFlow

With the recent Covid-19 pandemic there has been much discussion around how companies can adapt to new ways of working and become comfortable with a 'new normal'.

At PhixFlow, we have been making use of our internal PhixFlow applications which has enabled our team to continue their normal work from home. In fact, on the day the UK Government announced new measures to protect against the spread of Covid-19, where people should work from home where they can, PhixFlow's leadership team took the important decision to instruct the team to stay safe at home.

Remote access and virtual meetings

Unified communications: Remote Access and Virtual meetings are nothing new, especially for businesses in the technology sector and PhixFlow have been using such technology for quite a while. However, this element of remote working is usually less complex to solve. Giving employees access to internal systems and software is usually the biggest hurdle when enabling home working.

Keeping on target with Project Tracker

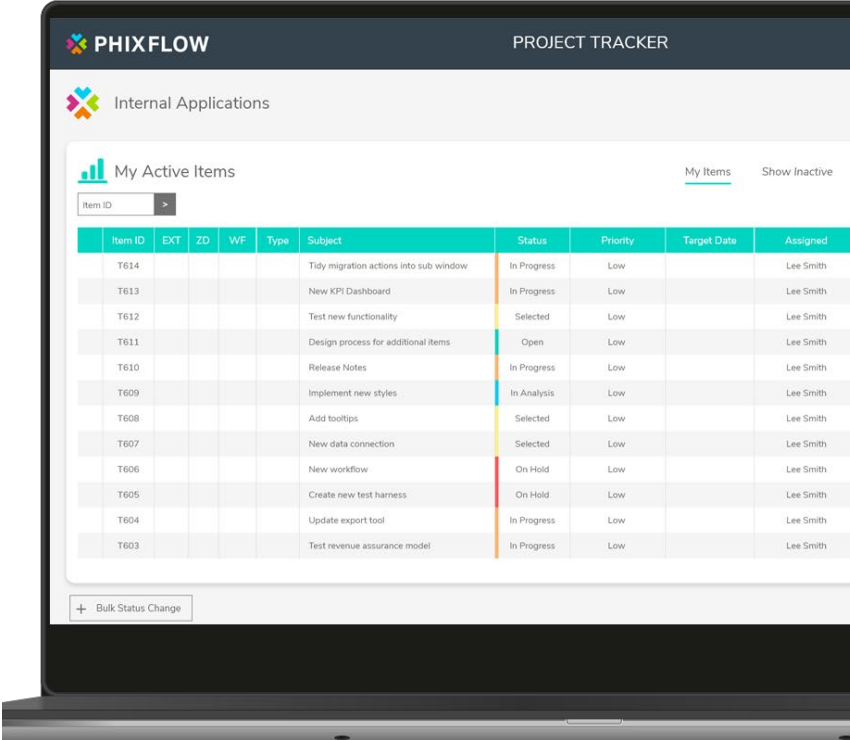

imperative that our consultancy and implementation teams continue to deliver projects quickly and on time. To achieve this we use Project Tracker, an application that we created internally, using PhixFlow.

This centralised application is available to all team members via a standard web-browser, allowing managers and team leaders to record the tasks required for any project, prioritise, and allocate them to individual team members. Individuals are notified of any tasks that have been allocated to them and can give feedback on the progress for that task. When a team member has completed their tasks, they can visit the dashboard and look at any outstanding tasks and allocate them to themselves to aid the progress of other projects too.
